They manage the complex process of moving fresh produce across borders, focusing on finding buyers, negotiating contracts, ensuring quality standards, and handling logistics and compliance.

Freight forwarders are logistics agents or firms that act as intermediaries between shippers (businesses moving goods) and carriers (ships, planes, trucks). They manage the entire transportation process, including negotiating, cargo consolidation, documentation, and customs clearance to ensure international or large-scale interstate deliveries move efficiently and safely.

Exporting lychees requires strict adherence to phytosanitary protocols to ensure the fruit is free from pests such as fruit flies, litchi fruit borers, mealybugs, and soft scales. Common treatments include **phytosanitary irradiation, vapour heat treatment (VHT), or cold treatment.**

#### Approved Treatment Method for Australian lychee

- **Irradiation:** Often preferred for high-value markets (e.g., USA, New Zealand) as it is effective against fruit flies and some insects without affecting fruit quality. For New Zealand, a minimum dose of 150 Gy to 500 Gy is used, while the USA pilot program required specific quarantine pest neutralization.
